Annual DELAC Report Presented to the Board

Parent leaders from the DELAC Committee, Delia Sanchez, de Magana and Yahaira Sahagun presented the DELAC annual report to the Board. The DELAC committee monitors and shares information on State policies that affect English Learners, as well as advocate for students, ensuring the District is meeting the needs of its English Learners. The DELAC representatives recommended that the Board continue to support intervention programs, small-group instruction, differentiated instruction, Newcomer Academies, programs supporting multilingualism, mental health and counseling, and parent technology classes and leadership academies.

Board Presented with Update on LCAP Goal III - Supports for Learning and Goal IV - Family and Community Partnerships

George Schonborn, Director of Pupil Personnel, Karen Silberman, Ed.D., Director of Student Support Services and Special Education and Andres Antiles, Senior Network Administrator presented information on Goal III and the many ways the District is supporting students, both academically and social-emotionally, through the pandemic. Mr. Schonborn highlighted the counseling support systems offered and MVSD's focus on mental health and well-being. He acknowledged the District's community partners including Foothill Family Services, Pacific clinics and Caresolace. He also gave an overview of the support for foster youth and homeless students. Dr. Silberman reviewed the professional development offered to district staff including health and wellness programs and Mr. Antiles presented information on learning supports with technology. Priscilla Figueroa, Director of Family Engagement, Extended Learning and Migrant Education presented information on Goal IV including MVSD's community outreach such as vaccination clinics, ASPCA Mobile Clinic, El Monte Back to School Resource Fair, Family Engagement programs including the parent leadership academy, parent technology workshops, social-emotional workshops, and programs such as CPAC focusing on social emotional strengths, Raising a Reader, and Family Biliteracy.
