Report on the One-Time Supplement to the Annual Update for the 2021-22 LCAP Plan and Mid-Year Report Presented

Dr. Jeff Lagozzino, Interim Assistant Superintendent of Educational Services, presented a Mid-Year LCAP Update to the Board, which included information on the additional one-time state and federal funding sources provided this year and Assembly Bill 130. He shared the District's plans to use additional concentration grant add-on funding in targeted areas to expand and enhance actions and services in the 2021-2022 LCAP including ELA, ELD, Content Literacy, and Mathematics; Science and Engineering; Visual and Performing Arts; Physical Education; Extended Day and Summer Programs; and Social Emotional Learning.

Educational Services Directors, Priscilla Figueroa and Dr. Karen Silberman presented an overview of Goal II of the District's LCAP, highlighting Goal II's focus including ELL Support, Student Support & Special Education, English Learner Literacy Support, English Learner Extended Support Program, Newcomer Program, Dual Language Programmatic Support, and Foster Youth.
