Update on LCAP Goal III - Supports for Learning and Goal IV - Family and Community Partnerships Presented to the Board

Stacey De Knikker, Director of Student Support Services and Special Education and George Schonborn, Director of Pupil Personnel presented information on LCAP Goal III and the many ways the District is supporting students, both academically and social-emotionally. Mrs. De Knikker highlighted the District's comprehensive counseling program including that each counselor and site administrator participated in Hatching Results training and the counseling team collaborated to develop three social emotional learning lessons to present in every classroom from February to June. She also acknowledged MVSD's partnership with Foothill Family Services who provide monthly virtual mental health workshops on a variety of topics, and CareSolace which continues to provide immediate mental health support resources to the MVSD community. Mr. Schonborn shared the district's work to provide safe and orderly campuses including campus monitor training, Knowledge Saves Lives staff training, Playworks training at Parkview, Monte Vista and Twin Lakes, and child abuse and human trafficking curriculum to be used throughout the year. Priscilla Figueroa, Director of Family Engagement and Migrant Education, presented information on Goal IV Family Engagement including expanded community partnerships enabling the District to provide more community resources such as resource fairs, Happy Feet events, dental services, parent technology and first aid classes, health enrollment services and vaccine outreach. Additionally, the format for CPAC meetings has been changed to hybrid enabling more parents/families to participate, thus enhancing communication.
